## LAST WEEK: Desiree Pettit

Desiree introduced us to the 'Evolve at Typo Station' program that was founded in 1993, and has been offering opportunities for young people to make positive changes in their lives ever since.

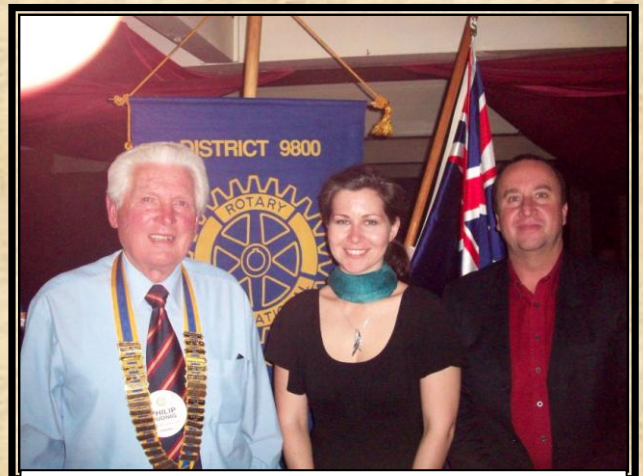
Using a former cattle-grazing property on the edge of the Alpine National Park - 'Typo Station' - the program challenges disadvantaged and 'at risk' young Victorians through a supportive environment to evolve into strong, caring and purposeful individuals.

With a 100km hike and pioneer-style living, they are taught life skills, such as effective communication and anger-management; also native and bush therapy practices are provided, enabling young people to take control of their lives and their futures.

Desiree is one of only two marketing staff working for Evolve. She has a varied background, with qualifications and experience in events management and marketing, and also in account management and anti-money-laundering compliance consulting.

Desiree has also worked for the Royal Agricultural Society and, having grown up in rural Victoria, she loves spending time up at 'Typo', seeing young folk develop over their two-to-three year journey with the Evolve program.

Desiree's talk was supported by a power-point presentation, and the interest of members was displayed at question time.

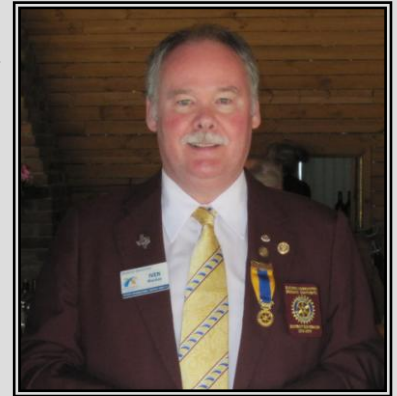
