Australian Rotary Health is one of Australia's largest independent health funds. To date Australian Rotary Health has funded more than \$26 million of research in Australia in a number of fields of health, including cancer, mental health, youth health, aged health and other disorders.

INTERPLAST

Some 28 years ago “Interplast” started in our District, providing plastic and reconstructive surgery to people in the Asia Pacific region. Contact was made by Rotarians in D9800 with the Royal College of Surgeons in the early 1980’s with the idea of establishing Interplast Australia. In 1983, Interplast Australia was founded. Rotarians to this day are on the Board of Interplast Australia & New Zealand, which determines the policy and direction of the organisation.

Since then, hundreds of overseas medical personnel have been trained, and over 80 surgeons have been sponsored to receive part of their specialist training in Australia.

Interplast has sent offshore over 600 volunteer surgeons, anaesthetists and surgical nurses on 500-plus programs to 25 countries, conducted over 31,000 consultations, and it is now approaching its 20,000th life-changing operation. See www.interplast.com.au
